- Inspect outlet and switch plates. Replace immediately if you notice cracks, warmth, or discoloration.
- Avoid overloading outlets. Use power strips with surge protection instead of stacking multiple adapters.
- Know your breaker panel. Label circuits clearly and learn how to safely reset a breaker.
- Unplug devices you’re not using. It saves energy and reduces the chance of electrical fires.

Boost Efficiency & Cut Costs

- Replace older bulbs with LED lighting for energy savings.
- Install smart plugs or timers to manage exterior lighting.
- Use ceiling fans to improve air circulation — they help both heating and cooling systems work more efficiently.
- Upgrade aging wiring if your home is over 30 years old; it can improve performance and safety.

Stay Alert for Warning Signs
